

## **Clinical Pearls**

- 1. PCV13 never needs to be repeated in an adult.
- 2. Once either vaccine is given at age 65 or older it does not need to be repeated.
- 3. Dose spacing
  - a. Five years between two PPSV23 doses.
  - b. Twelve months between PPSV23 followed by PCV13.
  - c. Eight weeks between PCV13 followed by PPSV23 for high risk patients, twelve months for all others.

Pneumovax<sup>®</sup> 23
