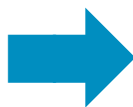


SBIRT | Screening, Brief Intervention, Referral to Treatment during Pregnancy

This is a common SBIRT workflow carried out in primary care settings and emergency departments. It can be tailored to best suit your needs.

Response

- The 5Ps screening tool is given to patients at least once during pregnancy.
- Primary care: verbal interview administered in the exam room when the patient is alone from a family member or partner.
- Emergency department: verbal interview administered by a behavioral health specialist before discharge when the patient is alone from family member or partner.
- Assesses substance use to indicate if a brief intervention or referral to specialized treatment is indicated.

- Primary care: delivered by the clinician or behavioral health specialist in the exam room when the patient is alone from a family member or partner.
- Emergency department: delivered by a behavioral health specialist before discharge, when the patient is alone from a family member or partner.
- Brief interventions are delivered when indicated on the 5Ps screening tool.
- Referrals to specialized treatment are delivered to patients when indicated on the 5Ps screening tool. Referrals to specialized treatment are conveyed through a brief intervention..
